





Pastor Carolyn's Conundrums

I know that everyone is consumed with worry and frustration about the current financial situation at Shores. I would like to let everyone know that Staff Parish and the One Board are working diligently to try to help alleviate the financial stress. In times like this I know that with worry comes passion around the issue. May I remind you to be kind? We are all concerned, we are all working toward solutions. Those options cannot be shared right now because they are just discussions. I can tell you that all options are on the table. As soon as something is decided we will let you know. What can we all do in the meantime?

Continue giving (of your time and money). If you love the church then withholding gifts to wait and see what happens simply isn't helpful. We need all gifts to continue to move forward. Pray, pray, pray! We are to talk all things to God. And then we must be open to hearing what

- God might be calling each of us to do. Be kind. I know I said this earlier, but it bares repeating. Being hurtful and disrespectful does not help the situation. I am not saying we have to all agree, but we do need to be able to have respectful conversations. How we respond and treat one another is our choice. Let us choose love and kindness.
- Refrain from spreading gossip and rumors. Not only are these on the list when Paul talks about sin in our life, but it only causes more chaos and hurt.

- Romans 15:13: "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing"
- Romans 12:12: "Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer"
- Psalm 62:5-6: "For God alone, O my soul, wait in silence, for my hope is from him. He only is my rock and my salvation, my fortress; I shall not be shaken"

Psalm 55:22: "Cast your burden on the LORD, and he will sustain you; he will never permit the righteous to be moved"

Finally, I love Shores UMC! I love all of you! I am helping work on every possible solution to set Shores up for the opportunity to grow and thrive. May we all remember that we are loved beyond measure. But this is not a stagnant gift. It is dynamic. God's love is meant to be shared.




